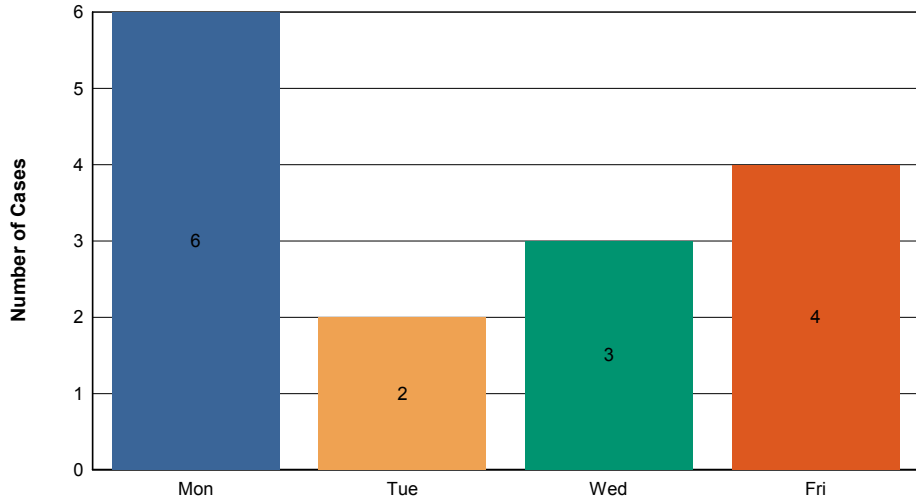
Statement of Limitations:

- 1) Any case number showing in red means the case status is "Unfounded."

- 3) Unfounded represents all cases unfounded in period, even if the offense was reported in a prior period.
- 4) Any suspect name showing in red means the case status is "Closed by Arrest" and is NOT specific to the name.
- 5) Any CS showing in red means the case status is "Closed by Arrest." Green means the case status is "Exceptionally Cleared."
- 6) Only incident reports where this offense is the most serious listed are included; victims listed are specific to the offense, not to the incident report.
- 7) Incident reports prior to April 2006 were transferred from another RMS (HTE); details may therefore be less reliable (i.e. victim not listed if not linked to offense).
- 8) Method of Entry and Point of Entry charts may not contain complete data prior to 1/1/07 due to lack of reporting.
- 9) Location Type: Business = [10-16, 29, 30-39, 49, 55]; Residence = [01-04, 08-09, 56].

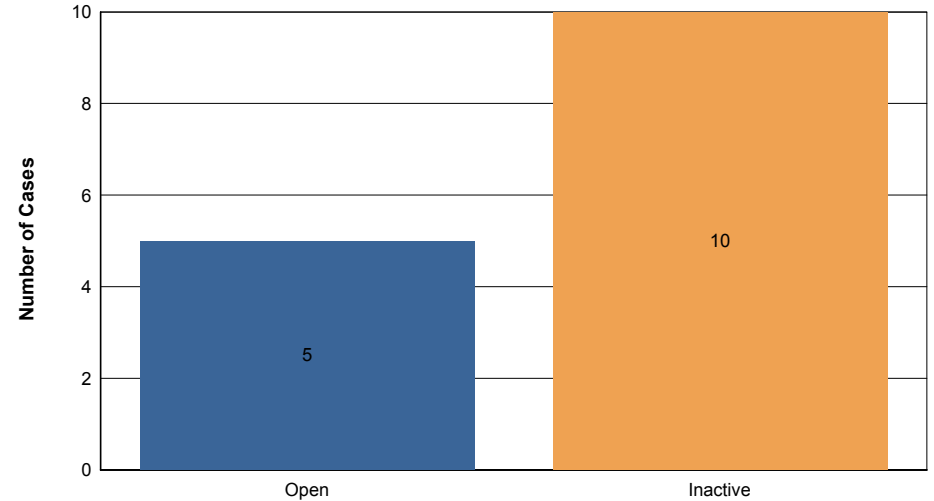

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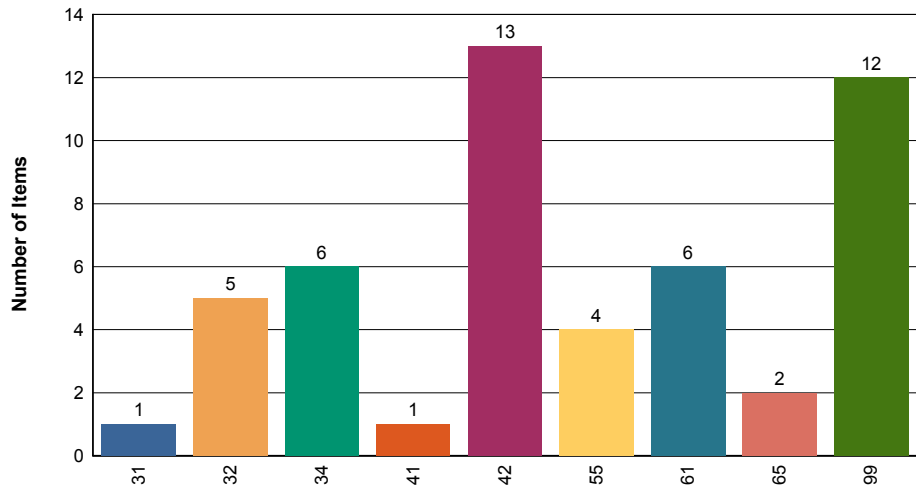
Burglaries by Day of Week

Property Stolen by Type



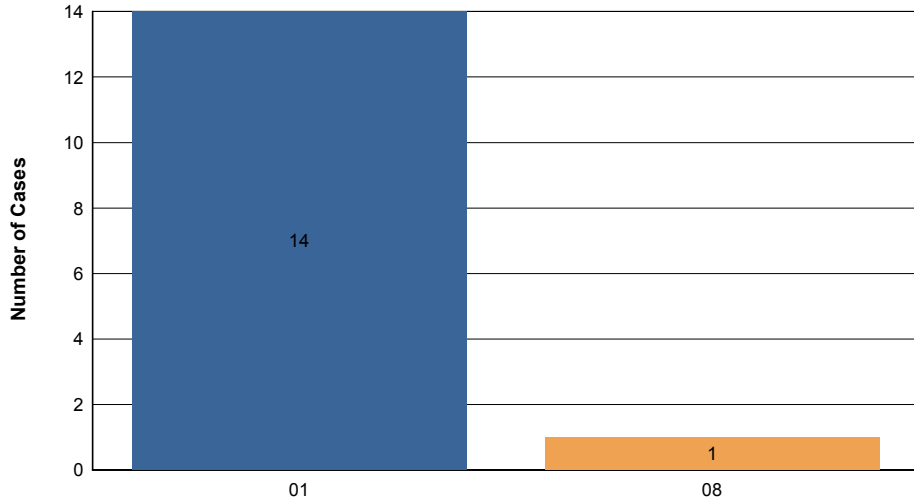

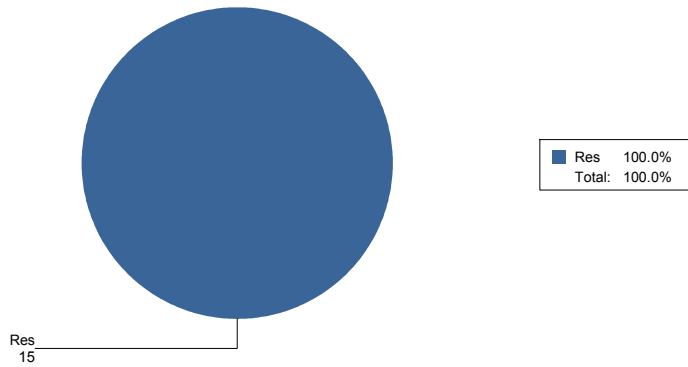

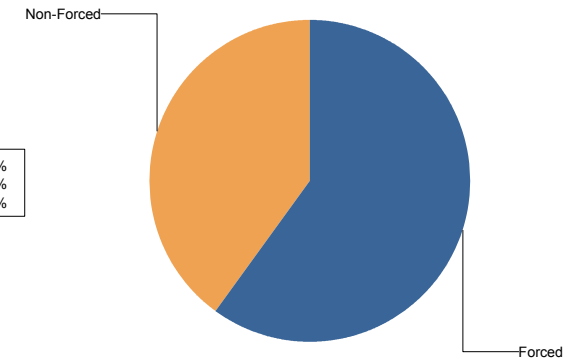

Burglaries by Location Type



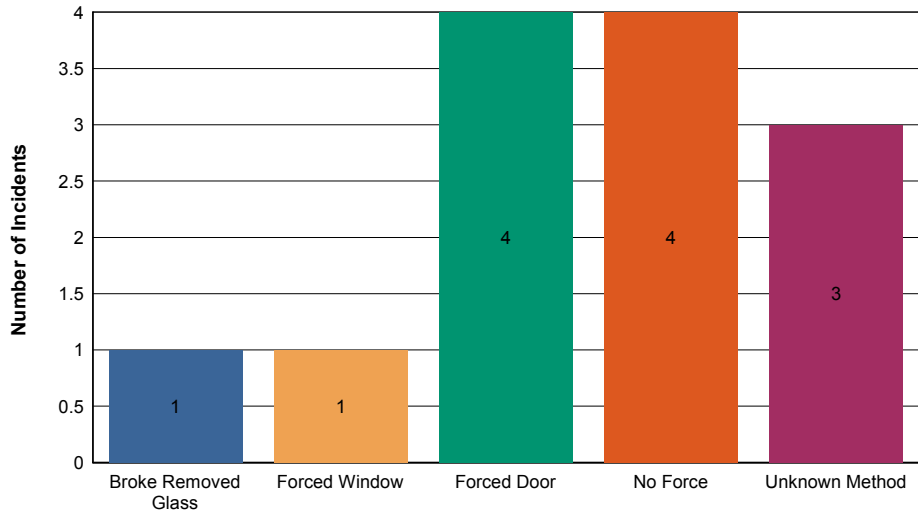
Burglaries by Offense Type



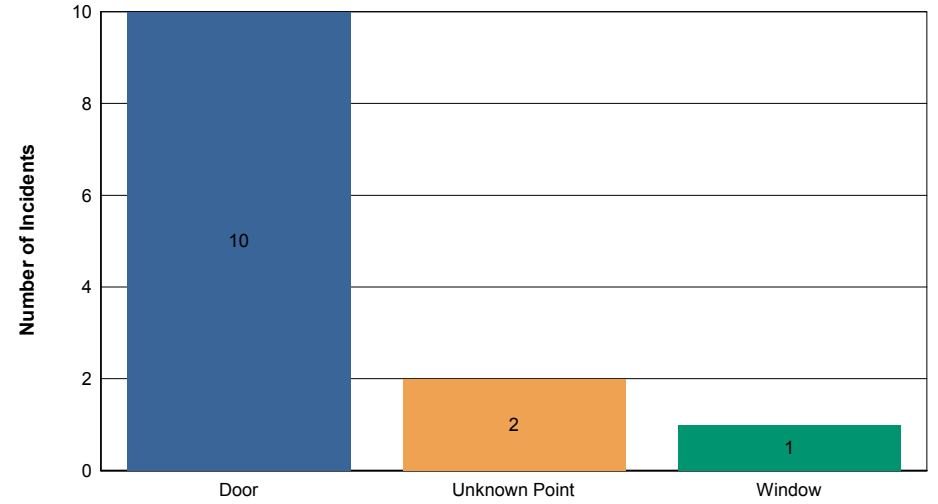
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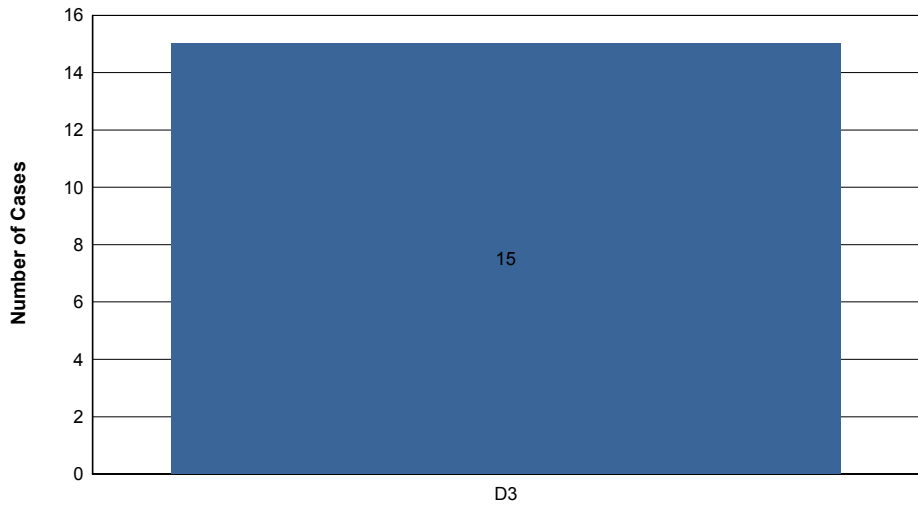
Burglaries by Method of Entry



Burglaries by Point of Entry



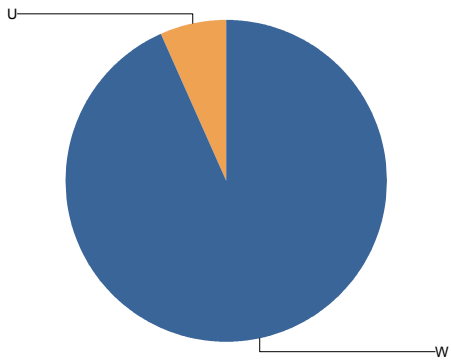
Burglaries by District



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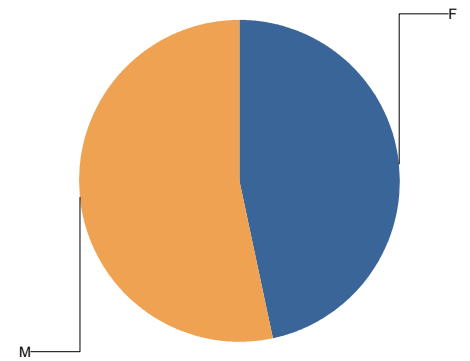
Burglary Victims by Race

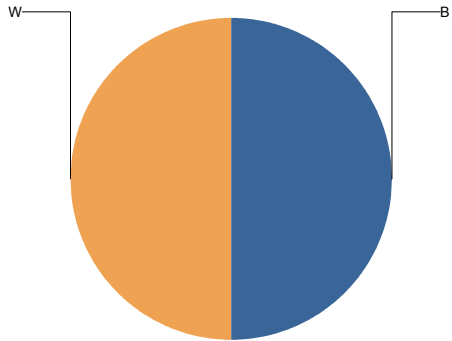
Burglary Victims by Sex

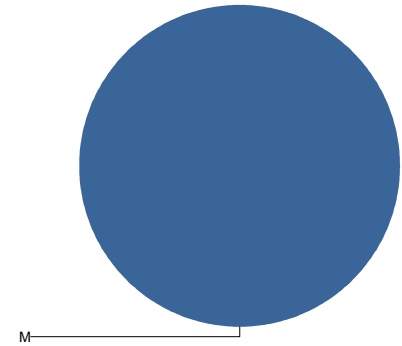
Burglary Suspects by Race
